**Meeting Place:** South Fork Visitor Center  
South Fork, CO 81154

**Getting There:** The Visitor Center is in the center of South Fork, at the junction of Hwy 149 and Hwy 160. (Note: vehicles will be parked in the South Fork impound lot, approximately ¼ mile from the Visitor Center.)

**More Information:** This is a long shuttle, approximately 3 hours. Please either eat before you meet us, or bring a lunch with you. Pack a jacket, it is usually chilly when we arrive at camp. Although we can't make any promises as to the safety of your vehicle, we have used this lot for years without any problems.

**Back to your Vehicle / Pick-up:** If someone is going to pick you up, have them pick you up at the meeting location as described above.

**Pick up time:** We should arrive back at the vehicles between 5 and 7 on Friday evening. You will have had a long day, and will most likely be tired. We suggest you make reservations for the night in South Fork.
