

National Park Pass Reminder

For Colorado Mountain Expeditions trips that take place inside a U.S. National Park, we ask participants who already have a National Park Pass—also known as an Interagency Pass—to bring it with them.

These passes include:

- America the Beautiful Annual Pass
- Senior Pass
- Military Pass
- Access Pass
- Volunteer Pass
- Every Kid Outdoors Pass (for eligible families)



Bringing your pass helps streamline our entry into the park and may reduce overall trip costs. If you do not have a pass, that is completely fine—CME will cover park entry fees for any participants who need them. We will simply check who has a pass at the start of the trip.

If you are age 62 or older, you are eligible for the National Park Service Senior Pass, which is an Interagency Pass that grants lifelong access to all U.S. National Parks and federal recreation sites. This pass is available as a one-time lifetime purchase or as an annual pass that can later be upgraded. If you qualify and don't already have one, it can be a great long-term value for anyone who enjoys visiting national parks.
